The Alpha Phi Chapter of Phi Kappa Tau would like to welcome you to the Third Annual Charity Hole in the Wall Classic Golf Outing at Sable Creek Golf Course. Proceeds from this outing will be benefiting chronically ill children by way of Paul Newman's Hole in the Wall Camps.

Paul Newman, a Phi Kappa Tau brother, founded The Hole in the Wall Camps in 1988. He realized that luck can sometimes play a dirty hand to those least deserving... and there are many who can make a major difference to those facing great challenges. The Hole in the Wall Camps were developed to provide children, ages 7 to 17, who battle chronic and life threatening illnesses with the opportunity to have a normal summer camp experience. Thousands of children come to camp every year, free of charge, for one week. They forget about their illnesses and simply get a chance to be a kid. In the words of Brother Newman: "Camp is a place where kids can kick back and raise a little hell."

The Phi Kappa Tau Fraternity adopted The Hole in the Wall Camps in 1995 at their National Convention in Washington, DC. Since that time several hundred thousand dollars has been donated to the camps and hundred of men have volunteered as cabin counselors, activity specialists, unit leaders, and other camp staff. As men of exemplary character, Phi Taus play a crucial role in providing much needed positive male role model support for these children.

Camp is not only a magical place for children with serious illnesses such as cancer, heart disease, asthma, sickle cell anemia, HIV/AIDS, hemophilia, epilepsy, and kidney disease, but also is a place where brothers have a profound service experience. Phi Tau is immensely proud of its partnership with the camps and has every reason to believe its participation will only grow stronger in the future.

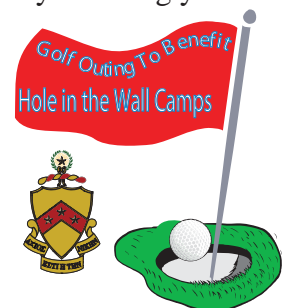
Chapter fundraising efforts allow The Phi Kappa Tau Foundation to make a sizeable

annual grant to The Hole in the Wall Camps. In 2006 over \$100,000 was donated to the camps as a result of the gifts from chapters, alumni, parents, and friends. It is a constant goal to increase the amount donated every year.

No child is charged to attend camp. It costs approximately \$1,200 for a child to attend camp for a week. # GOLF OUTING FORMAT & RULES:

1. Four Person Scramble Format. Select the best of your team's shots, and everyone hits their next shot from there within one club length no closer to the hole.
2. Tee Boxes
  - a. Blue Tees - Men will be playing the Blue Tees.
  - b. Gold Tees - Women will be playing the Gold Tees.
3. Must use one tee shot from each player in your group during the 18 holes.
4. Group A is the first group off each tee box.
5. Please keep up with the group in front of you.

## CONTEST PRIZE

### Maroon

Hole # 2 – Straightest Drive (a.)

Hole # 4 – Longest Putt (b.)

Hole # 7 – Proximity

### Black

Hole # 1 – Shortest Drive (c.)

Hole # 7 – Long Drive (d.)

Hole # 9 – Proximity

- a. Straightest Drive is the drive closest to the rope in the middle of the fairway regardless of the length. Please be careful to not move the rope while crossing with carts. Tie breaker goes to the longer drive.
- b. Longest Putt must be made from on the green.
- c. Shortest Drive may be anywhere.
- d. Long Drives must be in the fairway.

### Mulligans - \$20 / team

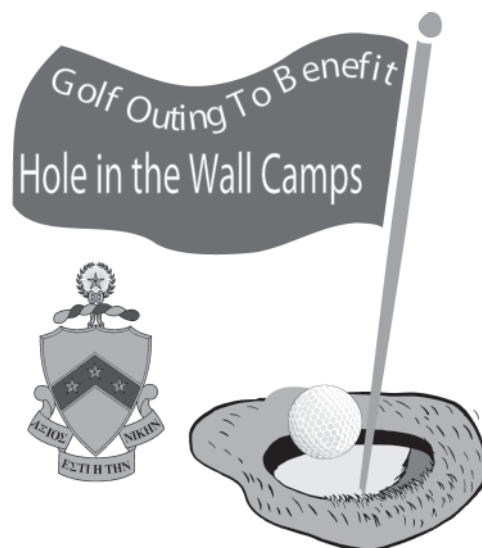
